#### **CONFERENCE FOCUS**

The Purpose, Passion, Mission Conference takes place online from 6 pm ET, Friday May 17 through 6 pm ET, May 18, 2019. This event includes various types of presentations and interactive elements with sessions scheduled every hour for 24 hours straight. #### **PLENARY SPEAKERS**

**Overview** - The plenary speakers both set the tone of the conference and also tie the content of the workshops and panel discussions together with the overall conference theme.

**Plenary & Tracks** – Each plenary presentation sets a framework for understanding the significance of the workshop presentations in it's related track. Each of the following tracks have a plenary presentation: missional theology, missional spirituality, missional witness, missional lifestyle, and missional disciplemaking.

**Plenary Topic** – An outstanding plenary presentation should present the information in an interesting way and demonstrate the applicability of the topic to both the track theme and the overal conference theme. Included in the plenary presentation should be some practical application of the content to the everyday life of the believer.

### **WORKSHOP PRESENTATIONS**

**Overview** - Workshop presentations provide an opportunity to present content within a context that promotes interaction with the audience. Please be prepared to share your content in 30-35 minutes followed by a Q & A session of 10 to 15 minutes.

**Workshop & Track** – Your presentation is part of a Track that is introduced by a plenary session and further developed by a panel discussion.

**Workshop Topic** – Please relate your workshop presentation to the overall conference theme and the central idea of the track. An excellent workshop is both engaging and one that invites further discussion and reflection regarding its applicability to real life.

**Workshop Proposal** – If you have been asked to give a workshop presentation, please go to page 11 and click on the appropriate link and follow the instructions to complete the online proposal form.

### PANEL DISCUSSIONS

**Overview** - Each track will sponsor a panel discussion that integrates the track with the overall conference theme and the track theme.

**Panel & Track** – The panel discussion will provide an opportunity for the workshop presenters and the track plenary speaker to discuss ways in which the content presented in the workshops further extend the themes expressed in the track plenary session. Emphasis will be upon the relevance of the information to everyday life.

**Panel Participants** – We are asking each of the workshop presenters to participate in the track panel discussion.
