CONFERENCE FOCUS

The Purpose, Passion, Mission Conference takes place online from 6 pm ET, Friday May 17 through 6 pm ET, May 18, 2019. PLENARY SPEAKERS

Overview - The plenary speakers both set the tone of the conference and also tie the content of the workshops and panel discussions together with the overall conference theme.

Plenary & Tracks – Each plenary presentation sets a framework for understanding the significance of the workshop presentations in it's related track. Plenary Topic – An outstanding plenary presentation should present the information in an interesting way and demonstrate the applicability of the topic to both the track theme and the overall conference theme. Included in the plenary presentation should be some practical application of the content to the everyday life of the believer.

Overview - Workshop presentations provide an opportunity to present content within a context that promotes interaction with the audience. Please be prepared to share your content in 30-35 minutes followed by a Q & A session of 10 to 15 minutes.

Workshop & Track – Your presentation is part of a Track that is introduced by a plenary session and further developed by a panel discussion.

Workshop Topic – Please relate your workshop presentation to the overall conference theme and the central idea of the track. An excellent workshop is both engaging and one that invites further discussion and reflection regarding its applicability to real life.

Workshop Proposal – If you have been asked to give a workshop presentation, please go to page 11 and click on the appropriate link and follow the instructions to complete the online proposal form.

PANEL DISCUSSIONS
